Music Policy for the use of on-site and off-site providers

At Glenelg Primary School we believe that;

Students should have the best opportunities to develop their musical potential and experiences, and in doing so offer programs across the school from an allocated 60 minute Music Lesson with a specialist teacher for all students, to lessons that develop personalised skills and experiences in identified instruments. The following programs support our beliefs.

ON-SITE STRINGS TEACHER (violin, viola, cello, double bass) through the Department for Education Instrumental Music program (IM) (lessons are free, although hire of instruments is \$180.00 annually). This is advertised through the school newsletter when the teacher is accepting new students from Year 3 and above. The process involves the following:

- Come and try session for year 2s.
- Consent to be a part of the program for the following year, and a level of commitment by parents to support practice and provision of instruments.
- Parents filling out and returning forms to the Deputy.
- Students generally receive 2 reports throughout the year which are sent home with the school reports.

DEPARTMENT FOR EDUCATION INSTRUMENTAL MUSIC PROGRAM – Brighton Secondary School – lessons are available in

- woodwind (flute, clarinet, saxophone)
- brass (trumpet, trombone, french horn)
- percussion (using drum pads for practice)
- electric bass

Information about commencement of lessons is made available near the end of the current year and at the beginning of the new year to Year 5 and above. Both of the above programmes also provide for ensemble playing. Some instruments are available for hire through IM. This process can be organised through the Deputy Principal.
