The summer season is split over terms 1 and 4 (i.e. the same team, with the same coach and manager, plays in the same grade in both term 1 *and* in term 4). Your child must be prepared to play both term 1 and 4. Should your child wish to withdraw; no refund will be provided.

Late Registrations: Children who submit late registrations will only be included in a team if a vacancy exists. Where there are too many children registering for a sport and limited coaches, children will be accepted first come, first served basis.

Uniform requirements	Navy blue school shorts and navy blue school polo
Equipment	Game equipment set up and provided by SACA, training equipment provided by the school
Adult Support	A team will not be registered unless it has a coach
Fees	\$50 total (for both terms). \$20 registration fee to be paid to the school. \$30 to be paid directly to SACA via a registration link which will be emailed once we have submitted the team registration. The \$20 can be made via QKR! or pay via cash/credit card at Front Office. Failure to pay by the due date will result in removal from the team.

Coaches and Team Managers: Glenelg Primary School extra-curricular sports run on the kindness and dedication of volunteers. Each team requires a coach (this can be shared between 2 people if preferred) and a team manager. Without a coach for each team we cannot register a team.

Coaching entails teaching players how to play the game, teamwork, positions on field, and conducting practice. The coach is to bring the first aid kit and T-Ball bag to the games.

Team Manager is responsible for communications of game details and organising a scorer. The team manager needs to take a team photo.

Coaches and Team Managers are required to complete the DfE Volunteer Application process.
