## Soccer

The winter season is split over terms 2 and 3 (i.e. the same team, with the same coach and manager, plays in the same grade in both term 2 *and* in term 3). Your child must be prepared to play both term 2 and 3. Should your child wish to withdraw; no refund will be provided.

**Late Registrations:** Children who submit late registrations will only be included in a team if a vacancy exists. Where there are too many children registering for a sport and limited coaches, children will be accepted first come, first served basis.

<b>Season dates</b>	
<b>Game details</b>	Squad Size: U8: 8-11 U9: 9-12 U10: 10-13 U11 & Senior Primary: 11-14
<b>Match Times</b>	Saturday mornings. Various kick-off times from 9am to 12pm. Each grade has a night carnival also.
<b>Match Venue</b>	Opposing team school grounds Home ground, front oval, Brighton Secondary – corner of Ilfracombe and Brighton Roads, North Brighton
<b>Practice details</b>	Depends on coach
<b>Uniform requirements</b>	School soccer shirt provided by Coach. Navy blue soccer shorts, shin pads, mouthguard, navy socks (socks available from the uniform shop)
<b>Equipment</b>	Provided by the School
<b>Transport</b>	Parents responsible for delivering children to the match venue at least 15 minutes before the game
<b>Adult Support</b>	A team will not be registered unless it has a Coach or Team Manager (umpires are provided)
<b>Fees</b>	\$50 per season (+\$40 uniform deposit for first season. Payment can be made via the QKR! Or pay via cash/credit card at Front Office. Failure to pay by the due date will result in removal from the team.

**Coaches and Team Managers:** Glenelg Primary School extra-curricular sports run on the kindness and dedication of volunteers. Each team requires a coach (this can be shared between 2 people if preferred) and a team manager. Without a coach for each team we cannot register a team.

**Coaching** entails teaching players how to play the game, teamwork, positions on field, and conducting practice. The coach is to bring the first aid kit and T-Ball bag to the games.

**Team Manager** is responsible for communications of game details and organising a scorer. The team manager needs to take a team photo.
