## Massaoke in Style End of Year Concert

Our End of Year Concert is approved to continue for Thursday 25<sup>th</sup> November. Whole school and individual year level communications have been sent home via Seesaw. Please refer to these for details of your child's requirements for the night.

### Concert Details:

- Tickets:** Due to capacity restrictions (2031) ticketing is required through Eventbrite. Please use the link to access your free tickets. Please note tickets are only needed for persons aged 14 or over. <https://bit.ly/gpsconcert21>
- Venue:** Under the COLA with families viewing from the JP yard.
- Time:** Gates will open at 5:30 pm, students to meet in their classrooms at 6.00 pm. The performance will begin at 6:30 pm through to just after 7:45 pm.
- BYO:** Chairs, picnic rugs etc. Please remember that this is an alcohol-free event.
- Coffee van:** A coffee and donut van will be on-site for the sale of refreshments.
- Raffle:** Parents and friends committee will be hosting a raffle on the night. Tickets are \$2.00 each or 3 for \$5.00. The raffle will be drawn on the night.
- Audience areas:** General viewing will be from the JP Yard. The school oval is available for families and little ones needing a break and a stretch. A priority viewing area for families of the year level performing will be established directly behind the student audience area. This will be cleared after each item to allow families of the next item to enter, providing better viewing and photo opportunities for all.
- Photography:** Please be mindful of others when taking photographs / video, and be vigilant to only share images that contain your child, close family and friends.

We are using a similar format to the 2020 concert presenting **"Massaoke in Style"** which will be a huge sing-a-long for everyone.

To make this evening a reality we are asking all families attending to respect the COVID requirements that we need to follow. Due to our restrictions, adult family members are requested to wear a mask and practice physical distancing, unless with immediate family and close friends. All visitors over the age of 14 are required to QR-code on entry or complete manual sign-in sheets that we are all familiar with from other public settings. We are aware that if the Level 1 Restrictions change in SA we will need to pivot quickly and alter our plans.

Adult toilet access will be minimal (JP block only) so please be mindful.

As we have a limit on visitor numbers (14years and older) Eventbrite ticketing is being used to monitor attendance. We have a capacity allocation of 2031 persons (excluding school staff and students). Please go to the link below to access your free ticket. # Emergency Management / COVID-19 Vaccination Information

Yesterday the Commissioner of Police announced the Direction that COVID -19 vaccinations will be mandatory for all people who work in an Education / Early Childhood setting. This applies to all sectors including Public and Private Facilities. This includes:

- All Education Employees and contractors
- All Governing Council Members and employees
- All volunteers / parent helpers (people who assist with reading, camps, excursions, canteen, fundraising etc.)

Under the Direction all of those mentioned above must receive at least 1 dose of a Therapeutic Goods Association approved COVID-19 vaccination and a booking to receive the second dose by 10 December 2021.

This does not apply to:

- Students
- Families at pick-up or drop-off
- Incidental visitors
- Urgent maintenance services

We are required to site proof of the vaccination and/or bookings. You can either email [DL.1017.info@schools.sa.edu.au](mailto:DL.1017.info@schools.sa.edu.au) with proof attached or you can come to the Front Office with proof for sighting.
