

Year 6 Jumpers



NIHONGO NEWS 1!

Our Japanese Hiragana Karate Challenge has returned in 2023!!

Throughout Term 1, our year 3 and 4 students (including the year 2/3s in room 20) worked very hard on learning the letters of the Japanese Hiragana syllabary. We call this learning the "Hiragana Karate Challenge", as students pass levels that we have connected to the colours of karate belts.

Each week in our lesson we learnt some Japanese letters and we used memory hints (mnemonics) to help us to remember the sound each letter makes. Students then worked independently to memorise the sounds they were working on. When they were ready to be tested, they asked their sensei for a recognition test. If they were successful in the test, they moved up to the next level. There are 10 levels to pass in order to achieve black belt level.

Once students have completed Black Belt, they move on to working towards being a Hiragana Master. To pass a Hiragana Master test, students must be able to recognise all 46 Hiragana characters in jumbled order and be able to use that knowledge in a word recognition test.

We were very excited towards the end of last term when we were able to award our first three Hiragana Master certificates for 2023!




Holiday Art Competition

ThinkUKnow Australia is an evidence based education program delivered nationally to prevent online child sexual exploitation.

ThinkUKnow Australia is a partnership between the Australian Federal Police, Microsoft Australia, Datacom and the Commonwealth Bank of Australia. The program is delivered in collaboration with policing partners New South Wales Police Force, Northern Territory Police, Queensland Police, South Australia Police, Tasmania Police, Western Australia Police, as well as Neighbourhood Watch Australasia.

The presentation will be delivered by a local law enforcement member and an industry volunteer. The presentation is pro-technology and addresses topics including self-generated child abuse material, online grooming, sexual extortion, and importantly encourages help seeking behaviour.
