From the Principal

Late sign in/absence

Please remember, if you are running late, all children need to sign in at the Front Office if arriving after 8:55, before going to their classroom. If your child will be away for any reason, the simplest thing to do is **SMS 0428 670 286 before 9:00am**, making notification easier for busy adults. Please don't message your child's teacher as lateness/absence is a central process and teachers are not actively checking email or Seesaw during class times.



Uniforms

The start of the school year regularly has all students wearing the current uniform. My overall observation is that this was the case last week. I would like to remind all the parents that **bike shorts or active-wear shorts are not a formal part of the school uniform**. Bike shorts can be worn as an undergarment underneath skirts, dresses or loose-fitting shorts for additional cover. Bike shorts and high-cut shorts, mini-skirts or very short skirts are not appropriate for our daily school wear. Children attending school in these items may be offered alternatives from our minimal supply or in most cases, parents will need to be called to bring in an alternative, more appropriate item.

New Waste Management System

As part of the Department's new waste management systems, all schools will be receiving new bins to separate our waste stream and promoting more environmentally sustainable practices. You will notice new bins in our yard over the coming weeks. Red for General Waste, Green for Organics and Yellow for mixed recycling. If you are walking past with your child, please take the time to look at the labels on the new bins and support their understanding of where to put their waste. It will be great for everyone if we can all support this initiative.

New Security Fence works

The installation of our new security fence is finally underway. There have been a few delays related to material supply and re-design work. The ultimate outcome is that Glenelg PS will be one of the most secure schools in the state. Entry/exit gates will be automated, allowing greater levels of control while the children are at school. The property will be fully secure out of hours, reducing the vandalism we face on weekends and evenings. Please be aware that there might be some teething problems as we establish the new system as well as some foot traffic diversions as the fence and gates are installed. All work should hopefully be completed in the coming two weeks.

Out of School Hours Care (OSHC) information

RECEPTION

Receptions are collected from their classrooms at 3.10/15pm by an OSHC educator and walked over to OSHC in one group – this process continues throughout the entire year. During Before School Care, Receptions will remain in the OSHC room with an educator until 8.45am when they will be walked to their classroom. An educator will be with them during this process to support them settling into their school day.

YEAR 1

Year 1s progress through phases throughout the year to ensure they understand and practise their transition to OSHC. For Weeks 1-4 of Term 1, children are collected from their classroom and also walked over as a group by an OSHC educator. From Week 5, educators will visit each Year 1 classroom at approximately 3.10pm and read out a list of children that are attending OSHC that afternoon. An educator will then meet the children at the web after the bell goes to assist them in getting to OSHC. From Term 2, children are still reminded in their classrooms, if they are attending OSHC and then they make their way to OSHC with their classmates on their own. This process will then remain for the rest of the year, however, does not continue into Year 2. During Before School Care, when the morning bell rings at 8.30am, Year 1s will be dismissed into the school yard with all the other OSHC children.

If you are the parent of a child in Year 1 and are concerned about your child making their way to OSHC on their own, please let us know and we will have a discussion with school and OSHC educators about what procedures could be put in place for your individual child's needs when transitioning to OSHC.

YEAR 2

Year 2s will be used to reminders in the classroom from when they were Year 1 so it is important to communicate with your child if they will be attending OSHC. Sometimes a note on their hand or a special bag tag can help remind them.


